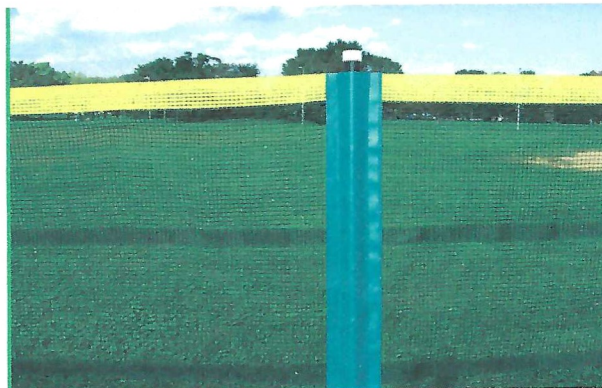
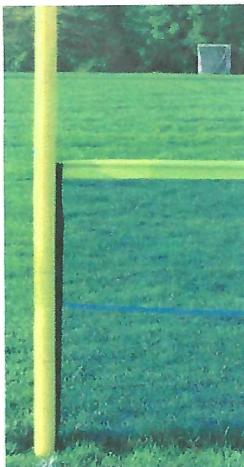
Completed Projects from Fall 2020-Spring 2021 for a total investment of \$25,000

- ✓ Pony Field dugout roof repair
- ✓ Batting cage and installation
- ✓ Turf installation in batting cage
- ✓ Soap and towel dispensers for bathrooms
- ✓ Assist with acquiring and installation of Pickleball court

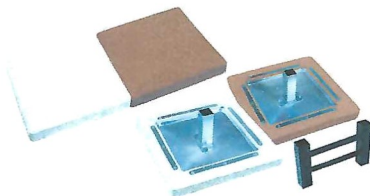
Forthcoming Projects for Fall 2021-Spring 2022(pending Wellsburg City Council approval)

- 1- Reitter Renovations & More, a local contractor, has submitted the following bid to help WBSA complete some minor repairs and maintenance on the park's facilities totaling **\$5,400**; \$4,200 in labor & \$1,200 in paint:
 - Pressure Wash: 6 dug outs, bathrooms (inside/outside) & concession stand
 - Paint: 6 dug outs, 2 sheds, Concession stand(inside/outside) & bathrooms (inside/outside)
 - Dug Out: Replace benches with composite boards on Field #2 and #3 & add gutters to Field #3
- 2- Field #1 Convert the T-Ball Field to a Multipurpose T-Ball/Pinto/8U Softball Field, this is due to our highest participation age group of 7-9 yr old thus having a higher demand for more Pinto/8U Softball size fields. To convert to a Multipurpose field total investment will be **\$3,500**.
 - Temporary outfield fence (put up in April and taken down in July)

*Tractor access was considered in planning layout of fence.



- New base set for 50' and 60' field dimensions only



- Grass infield

- 3- Field #2 Add additional 14 tons of infield top dressing, for a total investment of \$1,200
- 4- Field #3 Add additional 14 tons of infield top dressing, for a total investment of \$1,200
- 5- Field #4 Renovation total investment of \$4,500
 - Hydroseed 8,500 sq ft of grass on the infield
 - Add additional 24 tons of infield top dressing
 - Paint back stop fence

Estimated total project investments of \$15,800 to be completed pending Council approval.
